Trevor Pinnock is known worldwide as a harpsichordist and as a conductor, who pioneered performance on historical instruments with his own orchestra, the English Concert, founded in 1972. With it, he made a huge number of groundbreaking recordings (mainly for Deutsche Grammaphon) over the next thirty years. He now divides his time between conducting, solo and chamber music, and educational projects.

During the forthcoming season he continues his association with the Leipzig Gewandhaus Orchestra and Deutsche Kammerphilharmonie Bremen with celebrations of Haydn and Mendelssohn. He also appears as guest conductor with the Berliner Philharmoniker, Chicago Symphony, Royal Concertgebouw and London Philharmonic orchestras.

Chamber music tours include a programme of Handel and his sources of inspiration - 'Handel's Garden' - with soprano Lucy Crowe and colleagues on period instruments, and a programme with flautist Emmanuel Pahud and cellist Jonathan Manson. The recording of Bach Flute Sonatas they have made will be released by EMI in October.

Trevor recently released, to great acclaim, a new recording of Bach's Brandenburg Concertos (Avie label) with the European Brandenburg Ensemble, specially formed for his 60th birthday year. The ensemble will reconvene in 2011 for performances of Bach's St John Passion.

In educational initiatives Pinnock continues his work with the Royal Academy of Music, London, with staged performances of Haydn's 'L'Infedelta delusa', and will undertake his first session as guest artist at the University Mozarteum Salzburg.

In the 1992 Queen's Birthday Honours Trevor was made a CBE, and in 1998, an Officier of the French Ordre des Arts et des Lettres. He gave the very first Music in the Village concert on October 9th 2003.
