**February 18th 2010** Trevor Pinnock, the worlds most celebrated harpsichordist, returns to Music in the Village with a programme of music by Froberger, J. S. Bach, François Couperin and Rameau.

**March 11th 2010** The Virtuoso French Horn Renowned horn player Andrew Clark teams up with Richard Pearce, *piano* and Catherine Martin, *violin*. Beethoven sonata for French Horn; Brahms' beautiful trio for horn, violin and piano; Beethoven's "Moonlight" Sonata.
